### The Show

Living Movies - *The White Robe* takes our multimedia style to a new level by incorporating a second screen into the presentation. 2 live actors, 7 on screen African actors, 2 screens and an 18 year time span give the play a fast pace that tells the story of Seedlings and the impact it can have on just one life.

### The Team

Our touring team is made up of four people. We are pleased and honoured to have Dave and Nancy Seiling travelling with us again as they have faithfully led most of our tours over the years. They will be joined by a tech crew of 2.

### The Money

Our goal with these programs is to raise both awareness and funds for our ministry efforts in the 15 countries we serve. We do this by taking an offering at every event. It is not a hard sell offering, but simply asks those who feel led to give do so.

If a church is able then we ask that they add an honorarium to cover the expenses of driving down the road. This allows us to put more of the raised money directly towards the children. We recommend between \$300 to \$500 dollars for this depending on the size and resources of the church. This is not compulsory to booking us, but it is very helpful.

### The Room and Board

We ask for 3 beds to billet our team in local homes. This maybe for one or two nights, and on occasion it may be three nights if we are trying to give the team a day off in your community. Some of the team may have particular needs in terms of allergies and so on, but you will get that well in advance. We also ask that meals are provided for the group during their stay with you either at the billets or at the church.

## **The Timing**

This presentation is flexible and can fit into a number of scenarios:

Sunday Service:	At 1hr 10min, the show fits into a morning or evening service time slot
Evening Event:	Done as an evening event with an intermission for coffee
Dinner Theatre:	If you wish to plan a meal around the event – meal first then show
Desert Theatre:	Like dinner theatre only with pie – often served at intermission
Luncheon:	Sometimes at a regular lunch in your town

NB: In the past we have brought along a meal crew and supplies to put on the dinner ourselves. This became a very big operation, and we are not offering that option for this particular show. We will happily offer you recipes for an African meal if you like.

## **The Content**

As you may well imagine, this show deals with some mature themes and we recommend that children under 12 do not see it. We recommend child care be offered in another part of the building as a place for kids.
